**NARRATIVE**

**PRELIMINARY INFORMATION**

On Wednesday, 1/23/2019 at approximately hours, I met with Derrick Cox (W/M DOB: ) reference threats he received.

**COMPLAINANT/VICTIM STATEMENT**

Cox told me the following:

- he is a trustee with the Collinsville Township and is one of four individuals holding that office.
- recently, the meetings have become increasingly more disruptive.
- he received a threat from a white male by the name of Jim Stack who was an attendee at the previous night's meeting.
- during the Township meeting, Stack stood up and told him he would get him (Cox) later as he walked out.
- he perceived Stack's statement as a threat to a public official.
- that was not the first time since approximately two months ago another incident occurred as he was walking out of the Township building.
- during the previous incident, Jim Stack was with another male, Al Woolen, outside when Stack made comments to him (Cox) to the effect of he was going to get him one of these days.
- the meetings are now being audio and video recorded and he has a recording of the incident from the meeting.

**OFFICER'S OBSERVATIONS/ACTIONS**

I:

- reviewed the brief video segment which Cox had of the incident.
- saw Cox sitting at one of the tables at the front.

**NARRATIVE (continuation)**

- immediately recognized two of the Township officials as Mr. Terry Allan, who is the Township Supervisor, and retired Collinsville Police Officer Daniel Hopkins, who is currently serving as one of the Township trustees, sitting at the other tables in the front along with the other officials conducting the meeting.

- was able to hear arguing among the meeting attendees who were sitting toward the back of the room.

- observed Hopkins at one point to hold his hand up toward the citizen attendees as if he was trying to calm things down.

- saw an older white male, whom Cox stated was Jim Stack, stand up and turn to walk out after making some comments which I was unable to fully understand.

- heard Cox say, "Good, don't come back."

- saw the male walk out of view of the camera after which I heard a male say, "I'll get you later."

- heard Cox say it was Stack that made that statement.

- heard a female complain about it being a threat.

- heard another unknown male blurt out, "Shut up, lady!"

- saw that Cox had a printout of the Illinois Statute pertaining to threatening a public official.

- informed Cox that I would complete a report and submit it to the Detective Division for review.

- received a copy of the video from Cox to be entered into evidence.

On Friday, 1/25/2019, at approximately 1145 hours, I spoke with Dan Hopkins over the phone. From speaking with Hopkins, I learned the following:

- the discussion at the meeting started to become heated.

- Jim Stack was complaining and got up and began leaving.

- Derrick Cox told Stack, "Good, don't come back."

- Stack made a statement to the effect of he'd deal with him (Cox) later.
- he did not perceive the comments made by Stack as a threat as he believed there was no criminal intent and it was more of a matter of heated discussion which sometimes occurs at meetings.
- identified Jim Stack through in-house records as James E. Stack, Jr. [REDACTED]
