


SUPPLEMENTAL AFFIDAVIT

The undersigned, Amy Maher, under penalties as provided by law pursuant to section 1-109 of the Code of Civil Procedure, the undersigned certifies that the statements set forth in this instrument are true and correct, except as to matters therein stated to be on information and belief and as to such matters the undersigned certifies as aforesaid that she verily believes the same to be true.

1. I am a duly elected Precinct Committeeman in the Republican Party in Madison County, Illinois;
2. That on or about April 18, 2018 I attended the Madison County Republican Biennial Convention;
3. That I was elected to serve as Secretary pro tem during the Convention ;
4. That I was unaware of any conversations between Jeremy Plank and any person concerning a unanimous vote in the race for State Central Committeeman in the 15th District until informed of them by Chairman Jeremy Plank a few days later, in the same conversation in which he stated to me that there was a change to a unanimous vote in the 15th District in favor of Robert Winchester and that he had reported the vote from that District to the State Republican Party;
5. That during the convention I never engaged in any nodding or other indication of an opinion on the matter towards Mr. Plank or anyone else, and never stated any opinion to Mr. Plank;
6. That during the convention I sent a text message to Deb Detmers regarding the result of our County Chairman race, and she requested the results of the 15th District State Central Committeeman's vote;
7. I responded with the raw numbers of the weighted vote of those present;
8. That when the motion and second were made to make the vote in the 15th District race unanimous for Mr. Winchester, John Hansen, a former aide to Congressman John Shimkus was nearby, as we had been talking;
9. That soon after the motion was made concerning a unanimous vote in the 15th District, I received a text message from Deb Detmers, an aide to Congressman John Shimkus, contending that a unanimous vote should not be allowed;
10. That at the time I did not inform Mr. Plank or anyone else of the text message I had received from Deb Detmers;
11. That I shortly thereafter asked Mr. Hansen if he was in contact with Ms. Detmers, and he stated that he was in contact with her.
